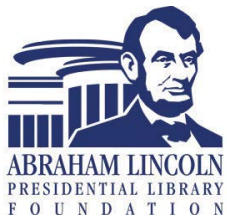


giving Tuesday

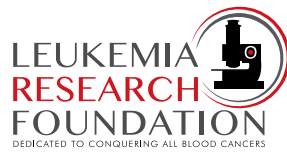
